Dear Business Partner,

According to section 1502 of The Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform Act, companies supplying the US-american market (even when only part of the supply chain) are required to disclose the country of origin of conflict minerals (tin, tantalum, tungsten, gold, and their derivatives). 'Conflict Minerals' refers to raw materials that directly or indirectly finance armed conflict or result in labor or human rights violations sourced from mines in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and adjoining countries.

Dietzel GmbH does not directly source or process any Conflict Minerals.


In the course of our procurement activities we purchase products exclusively from leading manufacturers who themselves have declared not to source Conflict Minerals from the Democratic Republic of Congo, Angola, Burundi, Central African Republic, Rwanda, The Republic of the Congo, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, and Zambia. Although we do not have any influence on the origin of raw materials used by our suppliers we actively support the traceability and transparency of their products.

Thus, we declare all Dietzel products „DRC conflict free“ according to the implementing regulation for Dodd-Frank Section 1502.
